-- First Year: HON 101, HON 105, HON 106 --

- \* HON 105 and 106 do not need to be taken in the first year if they do not fit into your schedule, but must be taken at a later date.
- \* These courses also do not need to be taken in sequence.
- \* HON 106 is only offered in Spring semesters.

-- HON 201, 301, 401 do not need to be taken sequentially. Below is the recommended sequence --

Second Year: HON 201--Third Year: HON 301--Fourth Year: HON 401

### -- Mini/Honors Topics courses: HON 110-120 --

- \* The topics of these courses change every semester; select based on personal interest!
- \* Students must take 3 in order to fulfill HC requirements but can feel free to take more than the required number.
- \* Can be taken at any time throughout program and can be taken together.
- \* Students entering the Honors College as sophomores are required to take two topics courses; those entering as juniors are required to take one.

### -- Thesis: HON 495/496: Honors College Senior Project --

- \* Two semester course. HON 495 must be taken FA of Senior year. HON 496 must be taken SP of Senior year.
- \* Can be done through student's major department and transferred over.
- \* Timely planning on student's end if required. Start your planning and consultation with an Honors College Advisors start of Junior year.
